2. Action taken for the recommendation of 5th meeting of Board of Studies. Action taken report in context to 5th meeting of BoS was discussed during the meeting

3. Introductory remarks on ***Scope of Interdisciplinary Board of Studies be informed:***

The framework of the UGC's Guidelines on CBCS has been adopted which calls for integrating courses under Ability Enhancement Courses, with the core and the interdisciplinary courses. Hence the University has included different concepts and type of courses under the following:

- a. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)
- b. Skill Enhancement Courses
- c. Finishing School Courses

Some of these courses will be discipline specific and could come under the purview of the discipline specific BOS for framing and recommendation. However, certain courses under the above two classifications, presently and in future, for both UG and PG programmes of the Atmiya University, could be general in nature. Hence a separate BOS as named above could have an integrated composition of experts representing general facets of education, who in turn, could frame the syllabus, evaluation norms and other related matters to place to the Academic Council for recommendation.

Discussion:

Samir Bisht was happy with the report of activities and achievements of NCC. He proposed to meet the Registrar in person so that they can discuss and work on the implementation of AICTE guidelines for NCC course.
 - Mr. Gaurav Makwana presented the syllabus and Dr. Samir Limbad was very helpful and has promised to share some certificate opportunities rather than making the syllabus in sync with physical education. He has also suggested to take the guidance of Mr. Makwana who is the senior sports guide and also our own retired faculty from Virani Science College. Limbad sir had suggested some content delivery of the course. He also showed interest to start the yoga and tracking course in the university which is offered by the government.
 - Mr. Jimit Talati, NSS coordinator represented the new CoC course of NSS which is divided in to four semesters. Which was appreciated and approved by the Committee and Lt. Divyarajsinh Jadeja appreciated the efforts and approved the same.
 - There is no change in this course syllabus of Concepts in co-existence for holistic living. Mr. Ajay Jain also approved the same.
 - Ms. Janma madam gave some valuable inputs to the course of IKS on Indian Fine Arts and its history which was well taken by Mr. Parth Lakum who will conduct the course.
